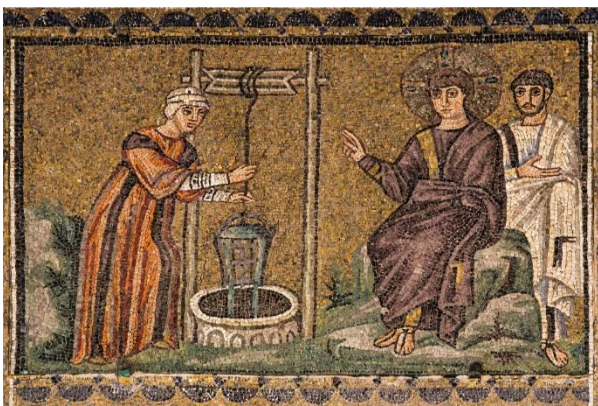
First Reading: Exodus 17: 3 – 7 'Give us water to drink'
